



National Breast Cancer Research Opportunity Halt Cancer at X - \$50,000 Grant

The Halt Cancer at X Committee is seeking grant applications for breast cancer research projects. We are looking for highly motivated researchers specifically geared toward breast cancer investigative studies. Potential programs/projects must be submitted for review by January 31, 2019.

The Halt Cancer at X Initiative is the brainchild of Sarah Broussard established in loving memory of her mother, Rebecca Chaney Broussard, who lost her battle to breast cancer in 2010.

Since 2012, Montana Equestrian Events, through the Halt Cancer at X Initiative, has awarded over \$300,000 in grants to projects specifically investigating ways to eradicate breast cancer and find a cure. We are currently reaching out to potential pioneers and breast cancer researchers in need of funding for new and innovative research projects. \$50,000 will be granted after evaluating criteria.

Applicants should have a PhD and/or MD, along with strong laboratory and analytical skills. We encourage you to apply by submitting:

1. Curriculum Vitae
2. A brief description of past research experience and accomplishments, as well as current and future interests. The lab receiving funding must have previously published on breast cancer research, have current funding for breast cancer research or have a co-principal investigator that can satisfy one or both of these requirements.
3. Project Prospectus (no more than five pages)
