



Halt Cancer at X Breast Cancer Research Grant-2020

The Halt Cancer at X Committee is now accepting applications for the 2020 funding of breast cancer research projects. We are seeking highly motivated researchers pursuing breast cancer investigative studies. Applications must be submitted for review by January 31, 2020. A \$50,000 grant will be awarded later in the quarter.

The Halt Cancer at X Initiative was established in 2012 by Sarah Broussard in loving memory of her mother, Rebecca Chaney Broussard, who lost her battle to breast cancer in 2010. Since 2012, Montana Equestrian Events, through the Halt Cancer at X Initiative, has awarded over \$350,000 in grants to research projects working to eradicate breast cancer and find a cure. We are currently reaching out to potential pioneers and researchers in need of funding for new and innovative studies.

Applicants should have a PhD and/or MD, along with strong laboratory and analytical skills. You are encouraged to apply by submitting:

1. Curriculum Vitae
2. A brief description of past research experience and accomplishments, as well as current and future interests. The lab receiving funding must have previously published on breast cancer research, have current funding for breast cancer research, or have a co-principal investigator that can satisfy one or both of these requirements.
3. Project Prospectus (no more than five pages)
